

ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW YORK, MINNESOTA, TO THE VILLAGE OF NEW YORK MILLS, MINNESOTA; AND ALTERING THE CORPORATE SEAL OF THE SAID VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, this Village has been duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Minnesota, and its present corporate name is the Village of New York, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the name of the post office in said Village, as designated by the United States postal authorities, is the Village of New York Mills, Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Council of the Village of New York, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

That the corporate name of said Village be and it hereby is changed, as authorized by Section 1193, Mason's 1927 Minnesota Statutes, to Village of New York Mills, Minnesota; and that the corporate seal of said Village be altered to refer to Village of New York Mills, Minnesota.
