

Ordinance No. 33

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE DATED, APRIL 7, 1941, RELATING TO THE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE SALE OF NON-INTOXICATING MALT LIQUOR.

The Village Council of the Village of New York Mills do ordain as follows:

Section I.

That Section I of said Ordinance No. 29, being an Ordinance relating to the licensing and regulating the sale of non-intoxicating malt liquors be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follow:

"that on and after the Seventh Day of April, 1942, the annual license fee for an "on sale" license shall be Seventy Five and No/100 Dollars, (\$75.00), and for an "Off Sale" license shall be Five and No/100 (\$5.00) Dollars.

Section II.

All Ordinances in existence which are inconsistent to the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed and declared null and void.

Section III.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
