

ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE DATED, OCTOBER 10, 1939  
RELATING TO THE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE KEEPING OF MUSIC  
DEVICES FOR WHICH MONEY IS CHARGED.

The Village Council of the Village of New York Mills do ordain as follows:

SECTION I.

That Section II of said Ordinance No. 24 being an Ordinance relating to the  
licensing and regulating the keeping of music devices for which money is charged be,  
and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

“That on and after the first day of May, 1942 the annual license fee for keeping of  
music devises for which money is charged or received shall be Twelve and  
No/100 Dollars (\$12.00) per year, payable in advance.

SECTION II.

All Ordinances in existence which are inconsistent to the provisions of this  
Ordinance are hereby repealed and declared null and void.

ORDINANCE NO. 24

ORDINANCE REGULATING THE KEEPING OF MUSIC DEVICES FOR WHICH MONEY IS CHARGED.

The Village Council of the Village of New York Mills, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

SECTION I.

No person or persons in the Village of New York Mills, Minnesota shall have or keep any amusement devise or music box or boxes in units on the floor attached to the walls in any restaurant or pool hall or public place for which money is charges or received, without first procuring a license therefore, from the Mayor and the Clerk of the Village.

SECTION II.

That such persons or person may procure a license as aforesaid for the sum of \$25.00 per year. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this ordinance and for the conviction thereof shall be fined a sum of not less than ten (\$10.00) Dollars or more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and, in default of the payment thereof shall be confined in the Village Jail for a period of not less than Five (5) days and not more than Fifteen (15) days.

SECTION III. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its publication. Motion made by Hultquist seconded by Lauley.
