

ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 32 WHICH IS AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REPAIR, UPKEEP, AND CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS.

The Village Council of the Village of New York Mills, does ordain:

SECTION 1.

That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 32 being an Ordinance which regulates the repair, upkeep, and construction of sidewalks be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

“That repair and construction of new sidewalk shall be so constructed as not to be less than four feet wide and four inches thick laid on a foundation of gravel which shall not be less than four inches thick.”

SECTION 2.

Be it further ordained that no sidewalk shall hereafter be constructed until a plan of said sidewalk is filed with the Village Recorder, said plan to state all the necessary information regarding to the construction of said sidewalk.

SECTION 3.

Be it further ordained that it shall be the duty of the Recorder to issue a permit for the construction of the sidewalk if said plans conform with the ordinances and regulations of the Village governing the construction of sidewalks.

SECTION 4.

All Ordinances in existence which are inconsistent to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and declared null and void.

SECTION 5.

This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication.

The foregoing Ordinance was moved by Councilman, Andrew Johnson, and seconded by Recorder, Karvonen. The following vote was duly recorded by the Recorder.

Ordinance was declared passed.

ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REPAIR, UPKEEP, AND CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS.

The Village Council of the Village of New York Mills, does ordain:

SECTION 1.

That whenever any sidewalk in the Village shall be out of repair, it shall be the duty of the village Recorder to give the owner or the occupants of the premises, in front of or about which such sidewalk is to be repaired or constructed, notice that the sidewalk must be forthwith repaired; and that if such owner does not repair said sidewalk, the Village of New York Mills will make the necessary repairs and assess the costs thereof to the said property owner.

SECTION 2.

It is further ordained that the repair of any sidewalk shall conform to the requirements of sidewalks already laid in the Village and that the sidewalk shall be five feet wide, not less than four inches thick, and shall be laid one foot from and parallel with the street lane.

SECTION 3.

It is further ordained that the building and repairing of sidewalks in the Village of New York Mills shall be done at the expense of and if by Village, shall be assessed against the abutting property, but that sidewalks across street intersections shall be built and maintained at the expense of the Village.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its adoption and publication.
