

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING SEASONAL LOAD RESTRICTIONS
UPON VEHICLES OPERATED UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS
AND HIGHWAYS IN THE VILLAGE OF NEW YORK MILLS,
MINNESOTA DURING THE PERIOD BETWEEN MARCH 20 AND
MAY 15 OF EACH YEAR.

The Village Council of the Village of New York Mills, Minnesota, do ordain
as follows:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

SUBDIVISION 1. For the purpose of this ordinance, the term "public streets and highways" shall mean all streets and highways located within the limits of the Village of New York Mills, Minnesota, whether the same are paved or not, except Front Street, which is also designated as Trunk Highway No. 10.

SUBDIVISION 2. The term "vehicle" means any device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except devices moved by human power or used exclusively on stationery rails or tracks.

SUBDIVISION 3. The term "single axle" shall have the definition as defined by Minnesota Statutes, Section 169.83 and the laws amendatory thereof.

SECTION 2. SEASONAL LOAD RESTRICTIONS.

No person shall operate any vehicle or combinations of vehicles upon any public street or highway in the Village of New York Mills, Minnesota, during the period between March 20 and May 15 of each year where the gross weight on any single axle shall exceed 5,000 pounds.


SECTION 3. PENALTY.

Any person violating this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its publication.
